BUSINESS ARISING FROM MINUTES:

Allan has spoken to Brenton Handke from Onkaparinga Association and a Sub committee is to be formed and meeting held before Christmas to look into an Inter Association Competition for next season. A survey will be prepared and issued to all clubs for feedback. A final decision will be made at the AGM in May in 2008.

SENIOR RECORDING SECRETARY REPORT:

Mike raised the following issues which need to be addressed by all club captains:

1. Team Sheets
 - team sheets need to be tidied up. Christian names must be on all score sheets
 - team names and team colours must be written on sheets correctly eg. *Hackham White Mixed Div 2*
 - there is to be no arrows on sheets – if an error has been made put a line through error and re write correctly.
2. Forfeits
 - If a player plays in another team they cannot be listed as a forfeit for another team as well.

3. Super Tie-breakers
Club captains are to explain the rules of super tie breakers to their players a little better. There is confusion amongst players and this is causing incorrect scoring.
4. Rules and By Laws
Captains to be aware of by laws – if a player in a higher division has a bye they cannot drop down to play in a lower division team.
If a player has played 3 matches for the one team they are then tied to that team.
5. Although there was inclement weather Mike was able to do a premiership table which was circulated amongst committee.
6. Div 3 Combined
Covered under general business.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

8.1 Div 3 Combined

Due to Pt Noarlunga withdrawing their team in the Div 3 Combined this left only 4 teams. After general discussions it was decided to combine Div 2 and Div 3 and make it a Div 2 Combined competition only. However Noarlunga Div 3 would not play in the Div 2 Competition so the men have been moved to replace the bye in Div 2 Mens Singles and the 2 ladies would become reserve players.

With the Div 2 combined all points will become null and void and all teams will have 3 weeks to establish their teams and colours before becoming tied to that team. The new Noarlunga Purple Div 2 Mens scores will be calculated at the end of the season.

8.2 Wet Weather

It was felt that under the current rules it is too easy for teams to cancel in wet weather and if teams cancel should they be awarded a premiership point. Is it fair on other teams that play and especially those teams that play and loose. By law to be reviewed next year. Other issues to be raised in by laws are the Super tie breaker rule and 2 team competition.
